Insurance is a very important part of the Safeguarding of children and Vulnerable Adults.

In this culture, where unfortunately litigation is rife, it is important that all Parishes have appropriate insurance in place for activities undertaken and that an audit of the insurance policy is regularly carried out.

- Is your insurance company aware of all the groups/events taking place under the banner of the church which you think are insured by them?
- Do they know in detail what the group/events are doing and where they are meeting?
- Have all users/hirers of Church Halls got suitable insurance for what they are doing e.g. Karate clubs etc?
- Are your volunteer's insured?
- Have the names of volunteers who work in the name of the Church and their roles been presented to PCC annually.

Parish life is fast moving sometimes and parishes occasionally take over responsibility for groups that were previously funded by an outside organisation.

If this is the case, has there been a proper hand over process and have you looked at what is required including insurance to continue to run this group?

If you are unsure of any of the answers to the above please check with your insurance company.

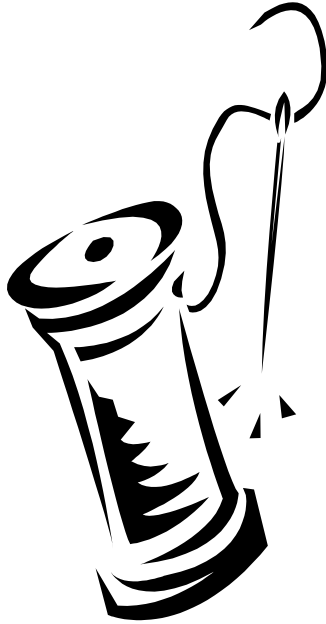
