## **Some ideas on how to tap in to precious memories – and have a really good time!**

### **Memory Triggers**

Talk about memories, teachers; who was in class, sticker books; memory verses.

Key message - Bible is full of God's love; he always loves us, always cares, recite likely verses e.g. John 3:16.

### **Sunday School Trips**

- Where did you go?
- How did you get there?
- Picnic food?
- Games played?

Be prepared to chip in with your memories to prompt theirs.

### **Singing on the way home?**

- What did you sing:

### **Sunday School Anniversaries and Prize Giving**

- Special Tea?
- Poems recited
- Who got a prize? (take one along if you still have it!)



## Choruses

- I am so glad that Jesus loves me
- I have a Saviour who's mighty to keep

Remember to keep the message of God's love and care to the fore.

You don't need a piano to do this; you don't have to be a world class singer! You need enthusiasm and a loud voice helps! Keep a list of choruses with you at all times!

You may have to brush up or learn choruses and be prepared to teach them to others.

- Sing choruses with actions
- Encourage joining in
- Go for it

***NB be prepared for several repeats!***
